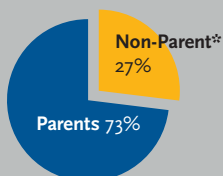

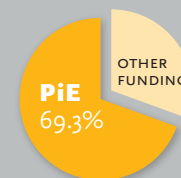

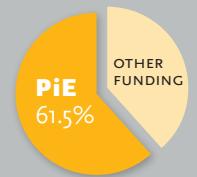

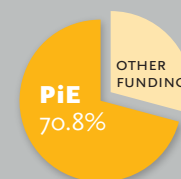
PIE IS THE LARGEST SOURCE OF FLEXIBLE FUNDING FOR PAUSD AT ALL LEVELS

We write this letter with enormous gratitude for your support and generosity to Partners in Education (PiE). How fortunate we are to live in a community that collectively values **our schools** and **our children** so highly. We are proud that PiE is **our education foundation**, a means by which we can help preserve an outstanding school experience for our kids.

For 2010-11, your generous donations allowed PiE to donate \$3.4 million directly to Palo Alto Unified School District (PAUSD) schools along with another \$115,000 for PiE Teacher Grants. PiE dollars now make up well over half of the flexible funding that our principals can use on their campuses. These funds have allowed PAUSD schools to maintain the kind of education that has helped produce well prepared, creative students, ready to face the challenges of our increasingly complex world.


